- Connecting to AHIF Services and other community services such as respite care, counseling, camps, support groups and ongoing therapy

AHIF Bright Ideas TBI Camp

AHIF has partnered with universities across our state to offer its Bright Ideas TBI Camp program. This multiday therapy-focused camp targets TBI survivors who are 3+ years removed from their date of injury, and are struggling with the challenges of adjusting to their "new normal" following their injury.
