

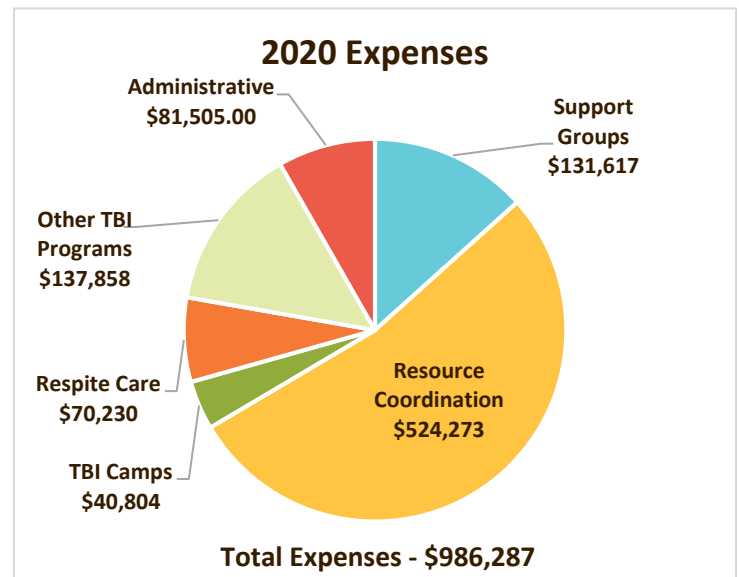
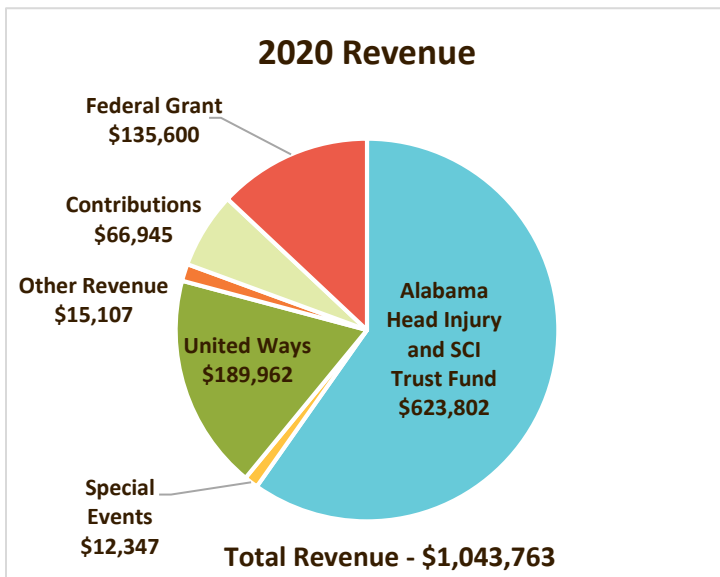
Resources & Financial Management

AHIF is a careful steward of the resources entrusted to us to accomplish our mission. We are proud to report an 8.3% administrative rate, meaning that only the smallest fraction of funds we receive are used to fund the operations of AHIF.

The majority of AHIF’s financial resources are used to support local programs and services in the communities where we operate. AHIF is proud to serve the entire state, and has active clients in all 67 Alabama counties.

Sources of Revenue

AHIF receives funding from the **Alabama Head and Spinal Cord Injury Trust Fund (AHSCITF)**, a fund created by the Alabama State Legislature and funded through a \$100 fine for each DUI conviction in the state. AHIF was also grateful to receive a \$125,000 line-item appropriation in 2020 in support of its programs and services across the state.

AHIF is also a proud partner agency of the **United Way of Central Alabama, United Way of West Alabama, United Way of Lee County, United Way of Marshall County, and the United Way of Etowah County**.
